Dr. Zaontz is a Professor of Clinical Urology in Surgery at the Perelman School of Medicine, University of Pennsylvania and is an attending Pediatric Urologist at Children's Hospital of Philadelphia. Dr. Zaontz completed his fellowship in Pediatric Urology at Children's Memorial Hospital in Chicago and has practiced pediatric urology exclusively for 39 years. Dr. Zaontz is an internationally recognized expert in the field of reconstructive pediatric urology with a special interest in Hypospadias. Dr. Zaontz has been widely published including over 180 articles, editorials and book chapters including the most recent chapter on Hypospadias in Campbell's Urology. Dr. Zaontz has produced many teaching videos for residents and fellow training covering the field with many on hypospadias reconstruction. Dr. Zaontz has lectured extensively internationally and has been an invited visiting professor to many institutions. Dr. Zaontz is a member of several prestigious organizations and has been president of the following: Mid-Atlantic section of the AUA (American Urological Association), American Association of Pediatric Urologists, Pediatric Urology Section of the AAP (American Academy of Pediatrics), and most recently as a past president of the Hypospadias International Society. Dr. Zaontz has been honored annually as a best doctor in Philadelphia and in Who's Who in Medicine.
